## **GENERAL BOARD MEETING**

Tuesday, February 3, 2026

President Mary Nelson called the meeting to order at 12:08 pm at the Palo Verde Restaurant Patio.

**MEETING MINUTES:** A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the general board meeting held on January 6, 2026. Motion approved.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Carole Healy (absent) emailed the treasurer's report to the executive board. It is posted in the ladies' lounge and will be posted on the PVLGA website. The balance as of January 31, 2026 was \$15,716.54.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Discussion was held to change the number of rounds needed to qualify to play in our four tournaments. Requests for changes to these rules must be reviewed by the General Board for approval. Proposed changes will be communicated (via email and website) to the membership to encourage member input prior to making a change in this document.

We need to follow the Standing Rules changes protocol before our Standing Rules can be changed. Proposed changes for 2027 will be PVLGA Po stable play rounds required from five to eight rounds needed for the Presidents Cup and the Club Championship, Member Guest will remain at five rounds, and Member Member will go from five rounds to none. As in the past, the club will continue to notify players when they do not qualify ahead of play. With minor new procedure changes IE: Jonus and Golf Genius.

Mary updated the board about past rounds that have not been posted and has worked with the club house to get these updated.

PVLGA League's changes to the new "Out of Bound Ruling" to speed up play is to accept the new ruling when a player's ball is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may take stroke and distance relief, or when Model Local Rule E-5 is introduced, the player has the additional option to drop a ball in and play from the relief area for two penalty strokes (see attached). Motion passed.
